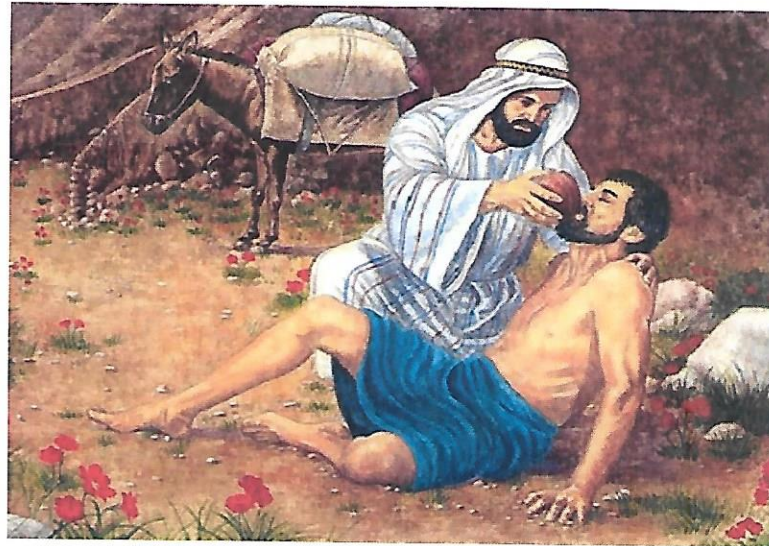
PARISH OFFICE will be closed on **THURSDAY, July 14, 2022** and **FRIDAY, JULY 15, 2022**.
